PSHE

We are learning about how we can respect differences and about laws, rights and responsibilities.

French

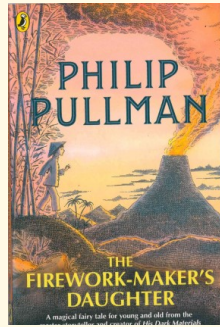
We will be learning how to ask for things in French, naming colours of different objects as well as knowing the different words for foods.

Geography
