

Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter

Spring 2

PSHE

We will be looking at internet safety, including age appropriate games and identifying something online that may upset or worry the children. We will be learning how to report something they have seen online. We will be looking at jobs and stereotypes through role models. We will also be recognising their own skills and interests.

French

We will be learning about family member names, pets, how to ask someone what their name is and the alphabet. We will also be describing the rooms the children's homes.

Music

We will be learning the song Three Little Birds by Bob Marley. We will also be listening to songs from other members of the legendary Marley family.

Reading



D&T

We will be designing and making our own bunting. We will learn what bunting is and why it is used, what different materials are used to make it and then design and start making! We will learn some sewing skills to enable us to put the bunting together.

Maths

We will be understanding denominators and numerators of unit fractions, understanding the whole and comparing and ordering non unit fractions.

Writing

We will be writing a narrative, a newspaper report and a letter linking to our story: James and the Giant Peach

Computing

We are learning about different methods of communication and how to open and respond to emails. We will learn how to use email safely and how to add attachments to an email.

PE

We will be learning how to improve cool core strength and agility and developing a range of throwing and catching techniques including overarm and underarm. We will also be building up skills to play cricket.

History

We are learning about WW2. We will be looking at why the war started, identifying the countries involved, the role of women who stayed at home and looking at wartime entertainment.

Geography

We will be using maps to identify European countries and capitals, including London. We will also be looking at the eight points of a compass and locating cities, counties, mountain ranges and rivers!

RE

We are learning about How and Why people try to make the world a better place. We will look into how the Christian, Jewish and Muslim religion tries to help make the world better and how non-religious people help to make the world a better place

Science

We are learning about fossils and soils. We will be identifying fossils as plants or animals, learning how fossils are formed, explaining the layers of soil and looking at the different rates of soil drainage
