PSHE

Phonics

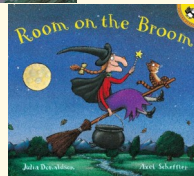
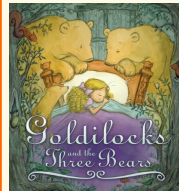
We will be recapping the Initial Code and will begin learning the Extended Code of Sounds Write. The sounds we will be learning are /ae/, /ee/ and /oe/.

Music

Art

We will be exploring different mediums (pencil, chalk, crayon). We will be creating our own self-portraits in the style of Picasso.

We will be mixing paint colours and creating an Autumn masterpiece using pastels.

Maths

We are learning about place value within 10, where we will be finding one more and one less and comparing numbers. We will also be adding and subtracting within 10.

Writing

We will be writing retellings of Goldilocks and Room on the Broom. We will also be innovating our own versions.

Computing

We are learning about how to stay safe online. We will also be starting to think about how to logically sort items using a range of criteria.

PE

We will be learning about the impact exercise has on our body and learning agility and co-ordination skills. We will be using balls, hoops and beanbags, while playing lots of games.

History

We are learning about what History is. We are looking at how we have changed over time and we will learn about the history of Robert Peel School.

Geography

We are learning about what Geography is. We are learning the 4 points of a compass and we will be beginning to compare Sandy to St Lucia. We will go on a local walk and draw a simple route.
