PSHE

We are learning about 'Living in the Wider World' and exploring the positives and negatives of social media. We are investigating the ways our data is used online and the impact social media has on our lives.

French

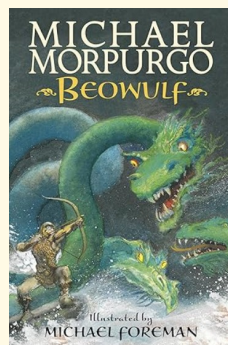
We will be learning to tell the time in French focusing on 'o'clock' and 'half past'. We will read and interpret timetables in 24 hour times.

Music

We are learning how to play the violin with a specialist teacher from Inspiring Music. We will be performing in a concert at school at the end of the half term.

We will be designing and making Viking-inspired hand puppets. We will practise different sewing techniques and then evaluate them.



Maths

We are learning about percentages including percentages of amounts and missing values. We will be looking at shape, in particular perimeter, area and volume. We will be looking at different graphs in statistics too.

Writing

We will be writing a diary entry as a character from Beowulf. We will also be writing an original narrative based on the themes within the story. Then we will write another diary entry based on our History learning.

Computing

We are learning about text-based adventure games and creating our own text adventure. We will be discovering about how the internet works and thinking about what the future might hold.

PE

We will be learning how to play rounders and demonstrating good agility. We will be participating in Pilates and developing sequences to challenge our core strength.

History

We are learning about who the Vikings were and where they originated from. We will be exploring why they travelled to England and how they arrived. In addition to this, we will be looking at their first raids of England.

Geography

We are learning about different kinds of maps and their uses. We will be recognising ordnance survey symbols and exploring from 2 figure grid references to 6 figure grid references.

RE

We are learning about Genesis and why some people believe Genesis is a detective story whilst others view it as a poem. We will be exploring scientific accounts of cosmology and evolution.

Science

We are learning about evolution, inheritance and adaptation. We will be exploring how animals adapt to their environment and how living things change over time.
