PSHE

We are learning about 'Living in the Wider World' and how we can protect our environment.

Reading

We are reading a GCP book about the Anglo Saxons. We will be focusing on the story of the invasion that led to the Saxons taking control of Britain.

Maths

We are learning about the relationship decimals, fractions and percentages have.

Writing

We will be writing a non-chronological report about the Anglo-Saxon invasion, a journal entry about caring for chicks and a Newspaper Report about Sutton Hoo.
